



WTBA Registered Testing Pool (RTP)

According to WTBA Anti Doping Rules 5.5.1 a group of top players are selected to be included in a Registered Testing Pool. Those athletes have to fill in their Whereabouts in an Administrative system (ADAMS). For this group of athletes WTBA will initiate out-of-competition tests anytime. That is why the athletes, in advance, have to register where they will be – every day all around the year.

WTBA has defined our RTP as follows:

- 10 best players in All Events for World Men Championship
- 10 best players in All Events for World Women Championship
- 5 best players in All Events, men and women in World Youth Championship

WTBA's RTP was implemented in 2011. The players from each category will be updated 1 January the year after each world championship. (*As an example the current 10 men and women players will be changed to the 10 best men and women in WC 2013 in Henderson/Las Vegas, USA 1 January 2014.*)
